Zechariah contains many prophesies about the Messiah:

- a) His lowly surroundings (6:12)
- b) His humanity (6:12; 13:7)
- c) His arrival on a colt (9:9; cf. Mat 21:4-5; Jn 12:14-16)
- d) His rejection and betrayal for 30 pieces of silver, and the potter's field (11:12-13; cf. Matt 26:14-15; 27:3-10)
- e) His crucifixion (struck by the "sword" of the Lord; 13:7)
- f) The piercing of his hands and feet (12:10; cf. Jn 19:37)
- g) His priesthood (6:13; cf Heb 6:20-7:1)
- h) His kingship and rule from Jerusalem (6:13; 9:9; 14:9, 16; cf. Rev 20:4-6)
- i) His coming glory (14:4) and destruction of Israel's enemies (14:3, 12-15; cf. Rev 19:11-16)
- j) His building of the Lord's temple (6:12-13)
- k) His reign (9:10; 14)
- l) His establishment of enduring peace and prosperity (3:10; 9:9-10)
- m) His expiation of sin (3:8-9, 13:1; Jn 1:29; Tit 3:5)
- n) The conversion of Israel at his return (12:10-13:1, 9; cf. Rom 11:26).
